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Dmytro Vynohradov is a hydrogen technology and sustainability expert holding a PhD in Physics & Mathematics from the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine. He currently serves as an Expert and Consensus Group Rapporteur for the European Commission in Brussels, where he coordinates and consolidates expert evaluations of hydrogen projects for the Clean Hydrogen Partnership. In this role, he assesses the technological maturity, industrial feasibility, and sustainability of projects across the entire hydrogen value chain. Previously, he worked as a Hydrogen Projects Developer at TendrisNL, focusing on R&D and industrial decarbonization projects.

With over 20 years of experience, Dr. Vynohradov has a deep expertise in hydrogen production, storage, and end-use systems, with a particular focus on durability and lifecycle performance. He has managed international R&D programs, co-founded a green hydrogen start-up in the U.S., and designed decarbonization strategies for energy-intensive industries. As an experienced EU Expert Evaluator, he has been central to providing policy and funding recommendations for EU hydrogen investment projects.
